Mission

History

DMEC is an employer based non profit organization founded in 1992. We provide our members a forum to discuss methods and procedures for program implementation through chapter meetings, seminars, virtual education forums, written materials and professional development courses.

DMEC formed an alliance in 1994 with the Insurance Educational Association (IEA) to develop the Certified Professional in Disability Management (CPDM) course of study. DMEC leaders participated in the curriculum development and have been responsible for all course revisions. At the completion of the three, eleven-week courses, students receive the designation "CPDM." Courses are now offered through IEA in both the classroom and online format.

In 1995, DMEC incorporated and qualified as a non-profit, professional educational association. In 1996 the first annual national conference was held and subsequent conferences are offered each year in the summer.
